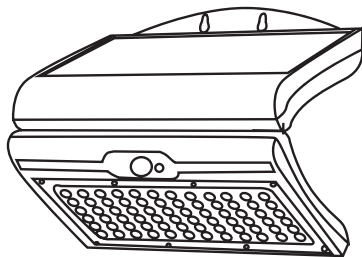




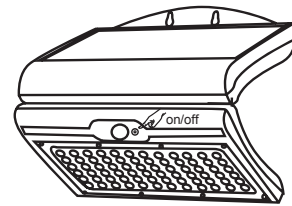

 Power > 30%	When remaining battery capacity > 30% The solar light automatically turns on at dusk at 3% full brightness, and turns off at dawn. When objects are detected, the light turns on at full brightness;
 Power < 30%	When remaining battery capacity < 30% To save the energy, the solar light won't turn on at dusk. Only when objects are detected, the light turns on at full brightness;

## Instructions for handling batteries

**WARNING! Risk of explosion! Batteries may contain flammable materials.**

When handled incorrectly, batteries may leak, become hot, ignite or even explode.

Please observe the following instructions:

- Keep batteries away from children.

- Do not inflict mechanical damage on batteries (do not dismantle, deform or pierce batteries).
- If any battery fluid comes into contact with the skin or eyes, wash the affected area with water and seek medical assistance immediately.

Cleaning, maintainng and storing batteries. To extend the working life of your batteries and ensure safe use, please observe the following instructions:

- If necessary, clean battery and appliance contact points before inserting.
- Remove flat batteries from the appliance immediately.
- Remove batteries from the appliance if it is not to be used for an extended period of time.
- Insulate battery contact points with adhesive tape before storing or disposing of batteries.

**Battery Disposal:** flat batteries should not be placed in household waste! Batteries must be taken to an approved collection point for old batteries.
