

Electrical connection wiring



Switch off mains power

Suspended:

Switch off mains supply and suspend fixture into position using suitable method (Optional carabiner available Part No: 430680)

Wire as per diagram ensuring a suitable connection method and/or junction box is used then reconnect mains supply

Surface Mount:

Switch off mains supply and secure the fixed bracket (Part No: 430679) to the fixture using the fixing kit provided

Using suitable anchor bolts and secure the fixture to the required location

Wire as per diagram ensuring a suitable connection method and/or junction box is used, then reconnect mains supply


